We Confess Our Sin

O gracious God, who may stand in Your holy place? You are of purer eyes than to behold iniquity. You condemn the ungodly and the disbeliever; but promise mercy through Jesus Christ, to all who repent and believe in Him. We confess that by nature we are children of wrath, and come short of the glory of Your holy covenant; but we did not always remember Our Creator, in the days of our youth. We have not pleased You and glorified You in all things, nor served You with all our might; but too often we have fulfilled the desires of the flesh. We have neglected and abused Your holy worship, Your holy name, and Your holy day. We have dishonored our superiors, and neglected our inferiors: we have dealt uncharitably with our neighbors, not doing to others what we would have them do to us. We have run into temptation; and the sin which we should have hated, we have committed in Your sight; both secretly and openly, ignorantly and carelessly, rashly and presumptuously, against Your precepts, Your promises, Your threats, and Your mercies.

But our hope is in Your mercy, Your Son, and Your promises. Be reconciled to us, and let the blood of Jesus Christ, cleanse us from all our sins. Sanctify us wholly, and shed Your love abroad in our hearts. Make us zealous for good works. Help us to redeem the time, and diligently make our calling and election sure. Keep us from sinful discontent and cares. Help us to watch against temptation,

and overcome the world, the flesh, and the devil- all through the grace and power of Jesus Christ. Amen.
